**Aim:** To make a word chain using time words

- You make a word chain when you write a word and use the last letter of the word as the first letter of the next word.

For example: appointment, time, early, yesterday.

- Work with a partner to make a word chain using words that are to do with time.
- See how many words you can make into a chain.
- Compare your chain with other pairs' word chains.  
Who made the longest chain?



## Pick a place

2–4 players

dice

**Aim:** To say time facts for different places

- Take turns to roll a dice. Each dice number means a different place:

1 a restaurant	2 our school
3 the doctor's	4 a shop
5 the playground	6 at home.
- Say a reason why time is important for this place or give a fact about time for this place.

For example, if you roll 2 for *school* you could say *We have maths on Tuesday morning* or *Lunchtime lasts for one hour.*

- If you can say a fact, you win 1 point; if you can't, pass.
- Keep playing until everyone has won at least 6 points each.
