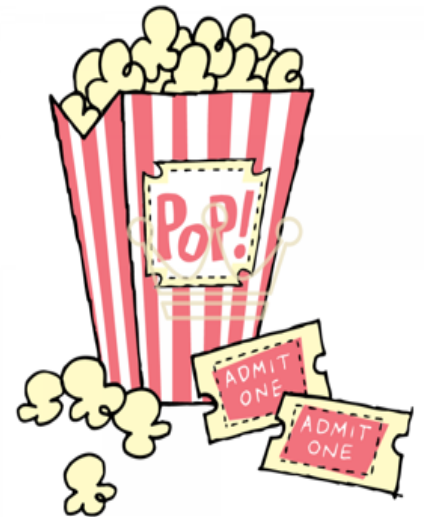


## Writing A Film Review

L1: Develop our literacy skills in a practical way.

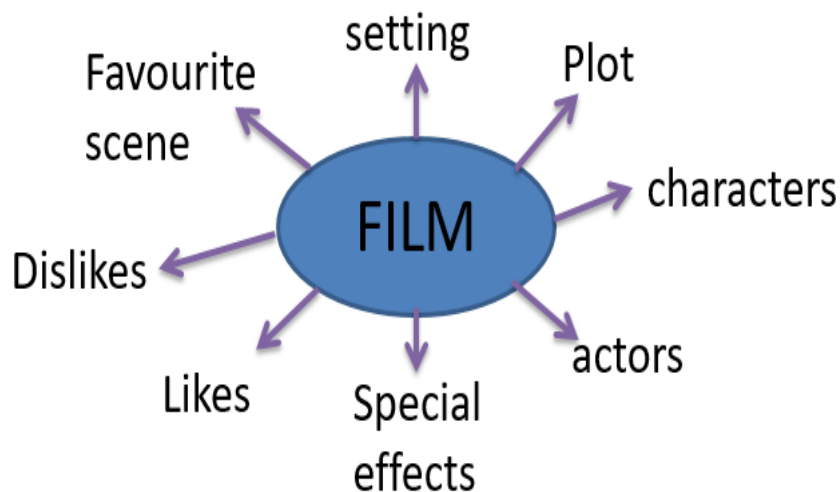
What is a review?

- Gives information
- Expresses opinion
- Gives reasons for opinion
- Provides an overall summary
- Focuses on key details
- Uses technical language (jargon)
- Uses persuasive techniques



Choose a film to review. You could choose your favourite film, or a film you have seen recently.

Brainstorm your chosen film, writing down as much information as you can.



Now write a review of your film following this structure:

1) Explain what the film is about.

- Don't go into too much detail.
- Don't give away the ending.
- What genre does it belong to? (horror, romance, action, etc)

2) Write about the actors.

- Who are they? What else have they been in?
- Are they believable? Do they do a good job?

3) Write about the good points of the film.

4) Write about the bad points of the film.

5) Write about your favourite part of the film.

6) Give your overall opinion of the whole film.

7) Finish with a star rating.
