Health and Wellbeing

Health and Wellbeing is a huge focus, especially during current times.

Last term we introduced Twiggle the Turtle and friends who helped the children recognise various emotions. We will continue to explore rules, relationships and emotions through PAThS (Promoting Alternative Thinking Strategies) and Growth Mindset lessons.

PE this term we will be focusing on ball skills. We will also be learning some social dances in preparation for the Christmas season.

<u>Literacy</u>

The children have been working on some of the initial sounds over the last term. We are now looking at recognising these sounds, using them to build 3 and 4 letter words and will begin to look at diagraphs (e.g. sh) later in the term.

Sight words will be issued via Dojo. These are words that the children should begin to recognise instantly. Daily practise of these words will help with retention and recognition.

All children will receive an online book at a time that is appropriate for their development.

Numeracy

The children will continue to work on the formation of numbers to 10 as well as counting forwards and backwards within 20, focusing on numbers before, after and inbetween before looking at sequencing small groups of numbers.

We will also be learning about time, this will include days of the week, months of the year, seasons and recognising o'clock on analogue and digital clocks.
