#### **School Improvement Plan**

Our priorities are:

- Pedagogy
- Embedding Inclusion, wellbeing and equality (Year 2)
- The CIRCLE framework/ The Promise

In Pedagogy we have been looking at the data for each class and short term targeted supports for groups of children have been identified. All teaching staff have also been devising purposeful play for their stages linked to the core skills. On the inservice day all staff had training on the CIRCLE framework. Staff are now carrying out audits to determine their action plan for the year.

#### **Early Years Centre**

We have 103 children enrolled across the whole centre. We have 93 3-5's, 30 2-3's (at the moment). We will be at full capacity once allocated children have started, so these numbers will increase.

Our new clerical assistant Ruth Hanlon started last week.

### **Centre Improvement Plan**

This session we will be focusing on the following:

- Learning, Teaching and Assessment
- Up, Up and Away
- Rights Respecting Schools increasing children's participation

We have worked with all new Early Years Workers to introduce the planning documents for the centre. The Early Years Teacher Virginia McKay and Natalie Beattie PT have met with all staff to discuss plans for this term and how we are changing tracking of children this term.

All staff have been part of the initial training for Up, Up and Away and will be attending authority training on October inservice day for this.

The children have worked with the Senior Early Worker to devise a children's charter for the centre as they begin to look at the Rights of the Child.

#### **Facilities Management:**

- New flooring was laid during the summer holidays in the ICT suite, Rm 16 and Rm 1.
- Planning of windows, boilers and stonework repairs as well as the repairs to the roof are all in hand with a plan and timescale to be confirmed. A report is being taken to the Council meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> September by the Major Assets Service with cost and timeline for these repairs and enhancements to the school. Due to Health and Safety concerns some of this work cannot be undertaken when the children are in school.

We await further updates and will let you know as we hear them.

#### **Events and Successes**

- Skills 31 has restarted for P4-7. We have been lucky to have some parent volunteers come to help in some of these.
- We had our House Captain elections and now have 8 new House Captains for the year. Mrs Mathieson is working closely with them to arrange House Huddles this Friday and the first monthly House treat for Kirk. They will introduce some of their ideas from their speeches over the year – one was to celebrate birthdays at assembly which we started this week!
- P1 parents had a Stay and Play at the end of August. This was very well-attended and parents were offered slots over the full week.
- P2-7 parents are invited in to an Open Afternoon next Thursday afternoon.
- P3 Rm 1 went to BBC Scotland studios to watch the filming of 'Get Set Galactic!' as some of the children had been successful in applying to be on the show. We will let you know when the show is due to be aired.
- The fundraising group giving teachers £100 to spend on classroom resources.

  Parents can see what staff and children decided to spend the money on via seesaw.
- We are looking to resume our lunchtime and after school clubs over the next few
  weeks. We hope that Terry from Drumchapel Table Tennis club will be able to
  resume his sessions with P5-7 on a Monday after school and Cross Country with Mrs
  Mathieson will resume shortly. Dates to be confirmed and information will be
  shared with families so that they can indicate their child's interest.

Homework - KS had been asked by a parent to raise query on homework as some teachers give it out and some don't. Mrs Smith clarified that homework is voluntary, and just there if families chose to do it. P1 is slightly different, with more traditional reading, phonics, letter formation being encouraged.

Parking - JMW wanted to point out that changes to parking at Bearsden Cross are proposed from October 2025

- Meters on New Kirk Road all on street parking
- Increase timings at Post Office car park to 8am 6pm (currently 9am 5pm)
- Large car park will be charged
- Still to go through Traffic Management Order and final consultation

CF pointed out there would be an option to put in representation to the consultation directly or through the Community Council.

WI- can we look at options for parents, WI to discuss with Breakfast Club.

Mrs Smith stated that there is a Travel Plan Officer at the Council and she will try to find out who this is as they would need to update the Travel Plan for the school if the changes go ahead.

Safer Streets Bearsden – if anyone would like to join the group please let Claire Willers know.

Mrs Smith leaving – JMW thanked Mrs Smith for all her contributions to the school and expressed that she would very much missed. Greg Bremner, Head of Education, is to contact JMW as she will be on the panel for selecting new Head Teacher. He will provide details of timelines etc.

PF raised whether payments be made online rather than cash/cheque only. Mrs Smith confirmed unfortunately it is EDC wide situation. JMW to contact Gavin Haire to discuss.

LH – some parents have raised concerns about where the fundraising money is spent as seems to be IT focussed. Can improvements be made to the playground? FG used to be very active on playground. CF asked Community Council if they will help the School improve the playground and said she was aware of potential sources of funding.

KS – reminded meeting that the Parent Council haven't been active on playground improvements due to Covid and then the redevelopment processes were underway so there was no desire to waste money on things which were going to be dug up etc.

CI confirmed that prior to Covid there was a plan but shelved at Covid and the refurb plans; this could be resurrected.

JMW agreed to form a sub committee and arrange a meeting to discuss.

A question was asked as to whether the old planter be removed? Gavin Haire has already agreed to get it removed. Basketball hoops also to be removed. Potentially FG can replace it and they will raise this at their next meeting. JMW also noted that new house captains get £250 to spend on playground equipment.
