<u>Literacy</u>

The children have been working on some of their initial sounds over the last term. We are now looking at recognising these sounds, using them to build 3 and 4 letter words and will begin to look at double sounds (e.g. ai) later in the term.

Reading will continue through this term, with a book issued every Monday. Please read these at home along with the sight words to help with the retention and recognition of these words.

Numeracy

The children will continue to work on the formation of numbers to 10 as well as counting forwards and backwards within 20, focusing on numbers before, after and in-between before looking at sequencing small groups of numbers.

We will also be learning about 2D and 3D shapes, focusing the names and main features of these shapes.

In PE this term we will be focusing on ball skills. We will also be learning some social dances in preparation for our Christmas parties.
